Fondazione Sozzani presents the book *L'era dei tiranni. Cosa ci ha insegnato il XX secolo*?, written by Timothy Snyder and illustrated by Nora Krug. The author of great works on Europe under Hitler and Stalin and on the holocaust, warns us: we are not safe from the bloody totalitarianisms of the twentieth century. But we have an advantage, we can learn from history. And from our recent past. For this Snyder has drawn twenty lessons to avoid repeating today, between nationalisms and populisms, the mistakes of a tragic era, that era of tyrants of which Nora Krug gives us the echo, mixing her illustrations with photos and splinters of once that we wish would never happen again. Because if conforming to injustice is easy, resisting it is a choice of courage without it which freedom dies.

Timothy Snyder is levin professor of history at yale and has signed books such as the Red Prince (2009), Blood Lands (2011), Black Earth (2015) and Twenty Lessons (2017), presented here in an illustrated edition.

Nora Krug is the author of Heimat (Einaudi, 2019), winner of the 2018 national book critics circle award and named best book of 2018 by the «New York Times».
